

What are we going to do?

New traffic signals will be installed to improve access in and out of Millbrook car park. This will mean that vehicles exiting the car park can now turn right as well as left onto the A281 Millbrook.

Traffic management

You will see some work in the road taking place as of 15/01/18. Barriers and cones will be in place 24 hours.

Temporary traffic lights then will be put in place from 29/01/18. These will be in place between 20:00 – 06:00. The temporary traffic lights will be removed outside of these hours.

Please note that some work may require temporary traffic lights between 09:30 – 16:00.

Temporary traffic lights will be in place for 24 hours during later phases of the scheme. However work will only be carried out between 07:00-18:00.
