Have your say!

Public consultation on the latest version of the Guildford Local Plan closes at **noon on Tuesday, 23 October**

Here's how to make your views known:

If you go to the consultation homepage here:

you will see that you can either:

- open the Schedule of Proposed Main Modifications and fill in the boxes after each of the questions (you don't have to answer all of them, just the ones you are interested in)
- send an email to localplan@guildford.gov.uk
- write to Planning Policy Team, Guildford Borough Council, Millmead House, Millmead, Guildford, Surrey GU2 4BB

Please note that if you respond by email or letter, you must make clear which main modification each of your comments relates to by referencing the relevant number from the Schedule of Main Modifications. **The Normandy proposal is Main Modification 45, ie MM45, dealing with Policy A64.** You must also provide your name and email and/or postal address, and write in your own words, as cloned replies will be counted as one!

A reminder that the Plan proposes building 105 houses over 3 years on Green Belt land to the north of the railway line east of Glaziers Lane. This is a 7% increase in the size of Normandy, with no accompanying improvements in infrastructure.

Thank you to those who came to the Parish Council / NAG meeting public meeting on 2 October. Nearly 200 Normandy residents demonstrated their opposition to this proposal at this event.
