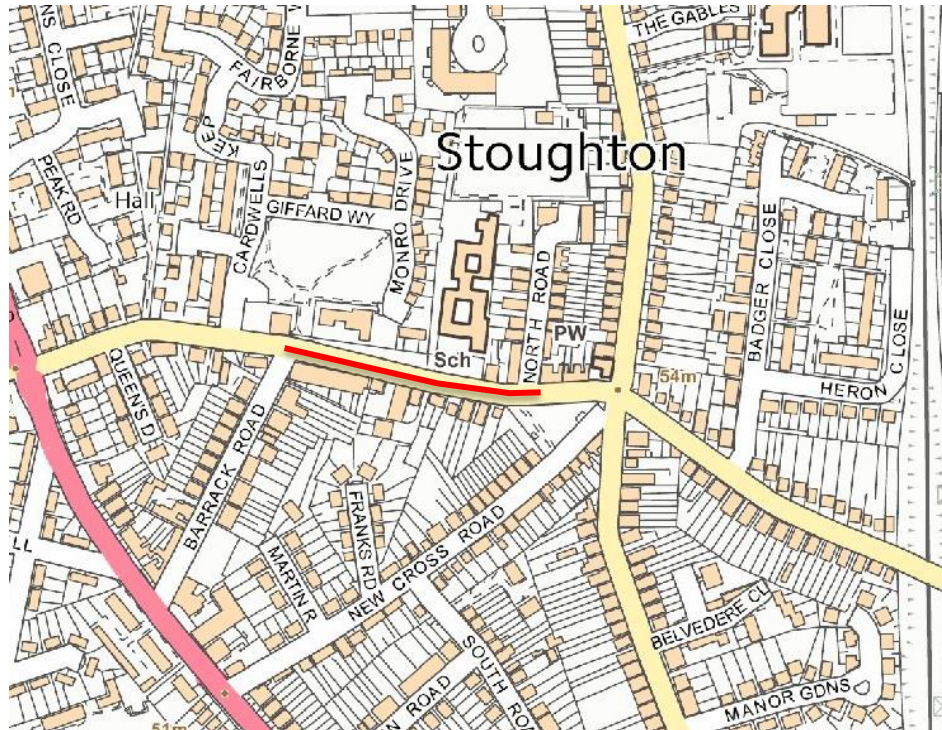

Information for residents and businesses

Stoughton Road will be closed from Barrack Road to North Road, whilst we carry out our anti-skid surfacing.

The red line on the map opposite indicates the road closure area required to complete these works.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

We initially contacted you in May advising of these works, however due to conflicting works in the area they had to be postponed. We apologise for any inconvenience this may have caused.
