What we are doing

We are carrying out carriageway resurfacing on Stoughton Road, Guildford.



Information for residents and businesses

Stoughton Road will be closed from the stop line east of the railway bridge to the stop line west of railway bridge, whilst we carry out our resurfacing works.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

Night works

Working overnight is necessary on traffic sensitive roads to reduce disruption during peak times. It also enables longer uninterrupted working before the closure has to be lifted for daytime traffic, and results in a shorter period of disruption.

Delays in work

Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather. We will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs. We will also update [one.network](#) with the latest information.
