

Overgrown vegetation

If there are any tree branches, hedges or shrubs from your garden that are hanging or growing over the pavement, please cut them right back to expose the full width of the pavement surface before our works start.

Delays in work

Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather. We will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs.

Parking

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles. Please park somewhere else otherwise your vehicle may be towed away.
