## 21/P/02566 Haytors, 208 Glaziers Lane, Normandy, Guildford, GU3 2EH

Proposed front porch, loft conversion with side dormer, single storey side and rear extension following demolition of rear conservatory and garden building following demolition of garage.

**RESOLVED:** The council objects as the application represents an increase of more than 50% of the original footprint and the proposal is not in keeping with neighbouring properties.

### 21/P/02647 Land at the rear of 75 Glaziers Lane, Normandy, GU3 2EA

Change of use application for the siting of 2 static caravans, 1 touring caravan and car parking following demolition of existing buildings, hard standing and fence.

**RESOLVED:** The council objects to the application as it is located within the green belt, there is sufficient provision for static and touring caravans in the local vicinity and the Parish Council shares the concerns raised relating to potential ground contamination and the presence of asbestos and Japanese Knotweed on the site.
